The term *used primarily in interstate commerce* shall mean that more than fifty percent (50%) of the operation of the vehicle shall be in interstate commerce.

The term *interstate commerce* shall apply to any trip by a commercial motor vehicle, excluding passenger vehicles having a seating capacity for nine persons or less, where the vehicle's cargo is loaded in one state; the cargo is unloaded in another state; or a part of the trip is in another state.
