

Boyle County Fiscal Court Ordinance No. 840

- (a) No owner, custodian, possessor or harbinger shall permit any dog to run at large other than on his own premises at any time, unless accompanied by the owner, custodian, possessor or harbinger and under his immediate control.
- (b) Whoever, being the owner, custodian, possessor or harbinger of any dog violates this section shall be fined not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each offense.

Boyle County Dog License

Boyle County Fiscal Court Ordinance No. 841 requires that all dogs wear a visible license tag.

- Licenses are \$5 for un-neutered dogs, \$3 for neutered dogs; kennel licenses are \$20 for 4-10 dogs; \$30 for 10 or more dogs.
- License tags may be purchased at any of the following places: the Judge-Executive's office in the Boyle County Courthouse, the Danville-Boyle County Humane Society, or from a participating veterinarian's office.
- Licensing must be renewed each year during the month of July or within 30 days of acquiring a dog.

Penalties: Dog owners who fail to display the license on their dogs face a \$15 fine for each dog; and \$100 fine for kennels (4 or more dogs).

Rabies Vaccination

State law requires that all dogs be vaccinated against rabies by the age of four months and revaccinated when the initial vaccination expires. The rabies tag issued by the veterinarian must be worn on the dog's collar at all times.
