

BOYLE COUNTY FISCAL COURT INVITATION TO BID

PROJECT: CERTIFIED VOTING SYSTEM FOR BOYLE COUNTY

Deadline: Friday, July 9, 2021

The Boyle County Fiscal Court is accepting sealed bids for upgrading and replacing the voting system in Boyle County, Kentucky. Sealed bids must be received by the Office of the Boyle County Judge Executive by 2:00 pm on Friday, July 9, 2021.

SPECIFICATIONS:

1. **Project Description** - Soliciting bid proposals for the following equipment:

- 20 Scanners
- 10 Accessible Ballot Marking Devices (BMD)
- 1 Print on Demand Device
- Necessary peripherals

2. **Proposals much include these core voting system requirements:**

- Complete system shall be EAC certified and conform to all applicable VVSG 2005 standards (not simply selected sections) and must meet all ADA requirements.
- System must include necessary documentation from the election administration committee verifying its certification and all accompanying independent lab reports
- Shall be capable of printing a uniform paper ballot on COTS paper, in the following sizes: 8 ½" x 11" and 8.5" x 14"
- Must have robust filtering and auditing functions
- Must have discrete user roles that enable delegation of tasks without violating security policies
- ISO 9000 approve technology required
- Hardware must have a sustainable system
- Ability to integrate with an electronic Pollbook is required.

3. **Scanner and BMD Requirements:**

- Must have common hardware platform with common user interface (same interface design for precinct scanner and for BMD);
- Must have Intuitive Interface that is easy to learn and use;
- Must have user interface that substantially meets the requirements of EAC/AIGA Design for democracy templates;
- Integrated Carrying Case for secure storage and transportation; the carrying case should be part of the device itself and not a separate case;
- Voter selection shall not be stored in bar codes;
- All peripherals including folding ballot box and booth must be capable of being transported in typical private vehicles, without requiring the use of dedicated delivery trucks;
- Have backup rechargeable batteries capable of being removed from the devices when not in use and shall be capable of being charged within the machine, while the machine is using AC power;
- Must include redundant data storage by default (not optional);
